

## Notice of Meeting

***Dundas Valley G&CC: Coined the ‘treasure in the valley,’ the course is reached by driving a main street of an historic Ontario town, fixed in a time warp.***



***It’s as if nothing has changed since the incorporation of Dundas in 1847, other than retailer names.***

***Then turn left at the railway bridge and***

***down Woodley’s Lane to the course, a former 135-acre dairy farm. You have arrived at the Thompson Classic. Entry form follows.***

*Notes for images on page 1, and above:*

- Dundas Peak overlooks the golf course; Tews Falls is located nearby; a Red Tail Hawk is one of the fauna to be found; golf is played alongside the Carolinian forest.
- King Street in 1930; and today with the Post Office clock still visible; the Town Hall, a pre-Confederation building; the 1861 John Bertram and Sons plant where munitions were made for World War I. The Bertrams were involved in the club, and Dundas. Dr. Thomas A. Bertram was a member and early Director, and a renowned curler. He was the founder of curling at the club.
- The first hole, a gentle par five, is down into the valley framed by the escarpment. The perimeter of the course is part of the Bruce Trail.
- The train station below the Dundas Peak and above the eighteenth hole of the golf course is where Their Majesties (King George VI and Queen Elizabeth) arrived in 1939. The Directors passed this motion: “*The Club extend the use of No. 18 fairway to all school children desirous of viewing the Royal Train as it passes through Dundas on Wednesday, June 7th, 1939.*”

The Society has its office on King Street close to the Post Office and opposite the building where the club was founded and Stanley Thompson, in 1929, presented his plans.
